

# Teaching Pastor/Speaker Development

## Full-Time (40 hrs/week)

### Role Overview

Primarily responsible for teaching at Weekend Services at Christ The Rock (50% of a calendar year) and investing in the development of other teachers/preachers on staff and in the body.

### Qualifications

- Significant teaching experience in a large group setting (5-10 years of experience preferred)
- Spiritual gifts in the areas of teaching and pastor along with the capacity to lead
- Practical ability to empower, guide and develop others
- Skilled and vibrant communicator
- Exhibits a heart for evangelism and a deep desire to reach the lost for Christ
- Ability to articulate clear vision
- Have a desire to help communicate and implement CTR's mission and vision
- Humble and willing to work as part of a team
- Commitment to personal accountability
- Model a Godly lifestyle in marriage, family and ministry areas
- A Master of Divinity degree or higher is preferred, but not required. Equivalent experience considered.
- Exhibits CTR's values
- Continuing Education required as directed by the Weekend Service Team Director

### Responsibilities

#### Teaching

- Devote significant time throughout the week to the study of God's word, prayer, spiritual disciplines and preparation for Sunday messages
- Preach approximate 50% of the Weekend Services in a calendar year
- Assist in the development of preaching/teaching in other CTR ministries (e.g. youth group, children's ministry, men's/women's ministry)
- Preach and teach occasionally in other CTR ministry areas
- Work with the WST Director and Discipleship Pastor to develop questions and/or material that connects to Sunday teaching for small group use
- Identify and equip additional teachers/preachers on staff and in the congregation

#### Leadership

- Oversee sermon preparation process
- Pastoral duties as determined by SLT
