WEEK 3 STUDY QUESTIONS

As we are learning more about the Holy Spirit, it is good for us to understand how He works, or what He does, in the life of a believer. This week, we will look at what Jesus said, but also at something Paul said, about how the Holy Spirit operates.

Read John 14:25-26

What sticks out to you about this passage?

What encourages you most about this way that the Holy Spirit works in our lives?

How can the way we understand this passage change the way we read the Bible?

Read John 16:7-15

How is this different than what John recorded in chapter 14? How is it similar?

In what ways do these works of the Holy Spirit most apply to our lives today?

What is one way you have seen the Holy Spirit do this kind of work in your life recently?

If you are a follower of Christ, you have the Holy Spirit, and He will ensure you understand what Jesus taught, as well as understand sin and righteousness. We also can leave the conviction and judgment up to God. Our job is to trust and obey!

Read 1 Corinthians 2:10-16

What can we learn about the Holy Spirit from this passage?

How does what Paul said to the church in Corinth still apply to us today? How could this understanding change the way we view God and our daily lives?

Make it Personal

This week, think about times when you trust other sources (friends, family, podcasts) more than the leading of the Spirit. Try to notice times when you could pray and ask the Holy Spirit to guide you or to teach you. Trust that He wants to do these things in your life.

Prayer

Father, thank you for sending your Son because of your great love. Jesus, we thank you for sacrificing yourself for us, and then rising from the dead on the third day. We thank you for sending us the Spirit to guide us in all truth. Holy Spirit, we ask that you would help us to be more like Christ. Convict us, lead us and guide us. We submit to your ways.
